Waterford Township Supervisors Regular Business Meeting Monday, March 3, 2021

Chairman Kondzielski called the regular business meeting to order at 7 p.m. Supervisors Malinowski and Senger were in attendance, as was Roadmaster Brian Tinko, Secretary/Treasurer Sharon Risjan, Zoning Officer Leeann Ormsbee, Larry Thompson, and Ron Eliason.

PUBLIC COMMENT – None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by Malinowski, seconded by Kondzielski, to approve the February 17, 2021, regular business meeting minutes, as presented. Vote: 2/0 (Senger was not present for this meeting).

ROADMASTER'S REPORT

- Brian rode with Earl Koon of Suit-Kote to get measurements for this year's road work. The
 numbers are more than last year; 117,000' compared to 70,500'. They went over the roads
 that need single coat. Surface treatment is 14,930' compared to last year's 20,869'. Himrod,
 Talcott, Clute and Colt Station must be sealcoated; these roads are only 4 years old and are
 falling apart.
- Shawn McLaughlin will be having back surgery so we will be losing an employee during that time. Brian would like some part time drivers.
- Would like to place the salt order for 2021/2022 season. Same as last year (325T).
- Would like to get our bank gravel, 2RC, antiskid, 1B and 2B aggregate bid.
- Asked if we are going to give Elk Creek Road back to Summit or keep it. We pay Summit \$2,180 to plow it and we have to do the rest of the work on it.

ZONING

- Subdivision for LeBoeuf Industries has gone through County Planning and Waterford Planning and is ready for Township review and signing.
- Waterford Township has received payment for a recent civil case found in favor of the Twp.
- Steve Halmi has responded about the Donation Road SWM waiver request. More information is needed. He will visit the site with a representative from Conservation. No decision at this time can be made.
- A Conditional Use hearing will be at 6:45 p.m. on March 17, 2021, before the Supervisors' meeting. This is for the cell tower conditional use on Hare Road. The Zoning Hearing Board will be holding a hearing on March 5, 2 p.m., for a height variance for the same cell tower, because it is over 45' high (actually 199').

 advising that Sharon Risjan has signature authorization to approve documents in
 RAS for the Niemeyer Bridge Project, upon direction of the Board of Supervisors.

Senger asked if there was anything new between our water/sewer authority and the Borough's Municipal Authority. Kondzielski said there is nothing new.

Roadmaster indicated that he would like to continue with the new surface treatment. The ones that were done last year were good.

Shearer's chip plant: They are requesting permit from DEP to build their own waste water treatment plant and send their waste water into French Creek. Application for the permit is open for public inspection at the current time.
